- · Wear gloves when handling wire rope. The following information is for installing and/or replacing the anchor pocket guard and plug.
- Use care when installing plug and guard. Avoid getting fingers pinched between the plug and tapping tool and the guard and drum.
- . Before installing anchor plug and pocket guard ensure wire rope comes off drum in an overwound direction, contact Ingersoll-Rand or nearest Distributor if wire rope is in an underwound direction.

It is not necessary to remove wire rope from winch to place the plug and pocket guard on winch unless the wire rope anchor interferes with proper installation.

 2. Disconnect main air supply to winch before performing any other changes to winch.
- Place plug in opposite hole from wire rope anchor.
- Tap plug into hole until plug is flush with the drum hole surface.
- Pull tabs of anchor pocket cover out slightly away from center of cover before installing in anchor pocket.
- 6. Position quard in pocket opening.
- Push guard fully into place. Ensure guard is snug.
- When removing the anchor pocket guard pry from anchor pocket. To reinstall follow steps 5-7.


